Perth Parking Management Act 1999

### **Perth Parking Management Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2011**

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

**1. Citation**

These regulations are the *Perth Parking Management Amendment Regulations (No. 2) 2011*.

**2. Commencement**

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

**3. Regulations amended**

These regulations amend the *Perth Parking Management Regulations 1999*.

**4. Schedule 2 amended**

- (1) In Schedule 2 item 1 delete “items 2 to 10)” and insert:  
  
items 2 to 10, 12 and 13)
- (2) In Schedule 2 item 11 delete “the items 2 to 10) —” and insert:  
  
items 2 to 10, 12 and 13) —

## (3) After Schedule 2 item 11 insert:

12.	<p>a parking bay for use without charge —</p> <p>(a) located on the site of a place of public worship of a religious body; and</p> <p>(b) set aside during the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. Monday to Friday solely for a vehicle being used by a person who, throughout the period the vehicle is parked in the bay —</p> <p>(i) works at the place of public worship as an employee of the religious body; or</p> <p>(ii) does voluntary work at or mainly at the place of public worship for or on behalf of the religious body; or</p> <p>(iii) visits the place of public worship for religious purposes or in relation to parish affairs of the religious body</p>	nil
13.	<p>a parking bay for use without charge —</p> <p>(a) located on or adjacent to a park; and</p> <p>(b) set aside during the hours of 8.00 a.m. to 6.00 p.m. solely for a vehicle being used by a person or persons who, throughout the period the vehicle is parked in the bay, engages or engage in a recreational activity in the park</p>	nil
