

# Access and Mobility Map Fremantle Boat Harbours

Your guide to accessing facilities in the area

Since Captain Fremantle and the HMS Challenger arrived to establish the Swan River Colony in 1829, the Fremantle Harbours have played a key role in the development of the City of Fremantle and Western Australia.

## Fremantle Fishing Boat Harbour

The Fremantle Fishing Boat Harbour development began with the construction of Ocean Jetty in 1873, located near the existing Cicerellos site.

In 1919 the first breakwater was constructed to provide an anchorage for fishing boats and further infrastructure has progressively been constructed to provide a larger sheltered mooring area, increased wharf and jetty space, as well as the provision of waterfront land for fishing companies and service industries. Between 1969 and 1972 the first pens were constructed and in 1982 a boat lifting facility was added.

Following Australia II's Americas Cup win in 1983, Fremantle became the focus of worldwide attention and major redevelopment occurred, changing the harbour's predominantly fishing industry focus to a world-class boating and tourist facility.

Today, the harbour has over 300 pens and berths; is the major fishing and marine industry refit site in the state; and incorporates a tourism precinct with approximately 10 restaurants and a boutique brewery.

In December 2011, the Fremantle harbours will again host the World's sailing elite for the ISAF Sailing World Championships – the biggest sailing event to be held in Perth since the 1987 America's Cup defence.

## Fremantle Challenger Harbour

Following Australia II's 1983 Americas Cup win major redevelopment of the Fremantle harbours occurred including the construction of Challenger Harbour adjacent to the

Fishing Boat Harbour to cater for syndicates participating in the Americas Cup challenge. These facilities have since been modified to accommodate recreational vessels.

Royal Perth Yacht Club Inc. as host club for the Americas Cup defence also built an annex at Challenger Harbour.

## Using the Access and Mobility Map

## Fremantle Train Station

Time	Frequency
Weekdays - Peak Periods	9 mins
- Off Peak	15 mins
- Evenings	30 mins
Weekends - Day time	15 mins
- Morning/Evening	30 mins

Peak periods 7:00am - 9:00am and 4:30pm - 6:30pm.

Express trains run during peak hours and do not stop at all stations - please check timetable.

## Fremantle CAT Bus

The Blue CAT services depart every 10 minutes and the Red CAT services depart every 15 minutes. Both services are free to use and run 7 days a week, including public holidays except Good Friday, Christmas Day and Boxing Day.

All of the Fremantle CAT buses are easily accessible with kneeling actions, a driver activated entry ramp and low floor. To board simply wait at any CAT stop.
