



Certificate of Competency Coxswain Restricted (Aquaculture)

This certificate of competency entitles the holder to:

- command an aquaculture vessel, of less than 12 metres in length, within the confines of an aquaculture lease and the vessel's direct daily transit to and from the vessel's mooring or normal operational base, in accordance with the vessel's certificate of survey, during daylight hour only.

Requirements to obtain certificate of competency: *(check that you meet the requirements in the order as numbered below)*

1	Age	18 Years
2	Eyesight test	Required on DoT form (valid for 2 years). <i>To be presented if submitting sea service for assessment.</i>
3	Medical	Declaration of Medical Fitness DoT form (valid for 2 years) <i>NOTE: It is recommended eyesight/medical tests be done before registering for any courses. DoT shall not issue a certificate if the minimum standards are not met.</i>
4	Sea Service	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One month commercial sea service completed on an aquaculture lease logged in a DoT sea service log book signed by the Master or Owner of the vessel, or • Two months commercial sea service logged in a DoT sea service log book signed by the Master or Owner of the vessels . • Recreational sea time will not be accepted towards this certificate.
5	Training	You must have successfully completed (within the last 5 years) an approved course for Coxswain Restricted (Aquaculture) with a DoT approved Registered Training Organisation including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current Senior First Aid Evidence of successful completion is required.
6	DoT Application Form	To be completed and returned to DoT with above mentioned documents, two passport size photos, fees & I.D.
7	Oral Examination	Not required

Additional Information:

- All documents submitted must be originals or certified copies.
- DoT fees to be paid on application.
- Revalidation of Coxswain Restricted certificate is required 5 years from date of issue.
- To obtain a higher marine certificate of competency it is recommended a DoT Record of Sea Service book is maintained to record sea service.
- Incorrectly completed forms will be returned resulting in the delay of the issue of certificates of competency.
