Temporary Notice to Mariners

Navigational Hazard

Installation of Temporary Operational Mooring

At the Barrow Island Port

Mariners are advised that twenty (20) temporary moorings will be installed at the following location at Barrow Island Port.

Mooring installation will commence on the 29 April 2010 until the 25 May 2010. Upon completion of installation the moorings will remain in place for approximately 18 months.

The operational moorings will be located in the area delineated by the following approximate meridian lines and shown on the chart-let below.

Latitude 20°47'S Longitude 115°28'E

Latitude 20°50'S Longitude 115°33'E

Each operational mooring will be fitted with a yellow/orange surface buoy and lit with a yellow flashing light.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when transiting the area and to remain well clear of the mooring buoys.
