**Temporary Notice to Mariners
Navigational Hazard
Deployment of Navigational Aids
Port of Barrow Island**

Mariners are advised that five (5) navigational aids are scheduled to be deployed on 20 December 2010 for a period of up to five (5) years at the following coordinates.

As plotted on AUS Chart 62, Datum WGS84, printed 03/09/2007.

WA Oil Pipeline Buoy No1 Special Mark (HB1) (1-5 yrs): 20° 47.262'S, 115°28.597'E
WA Oil Pipeline Buoy No2 Special Mark (HB2) (1-5 yrs): 20° 47.363'S, 115°28.845'E
WA Oil Pipeline Buoy No3 Special Mark (HB3) (1-5 yrs): 20° 47.464'S, 115°29.093E
WA Oil Pipeline Buoy No4 Special Mark (HB4) (1-5 yrs): 20° 47.565'S, 115°29.341'E
WA Oil Pipeline Buoy No5 Special Mark (HB5) (1-5 yrs): 20° 47.725'S, 115°29.797'E

Another two (2) additional navigation aids are also scheduled to be deployed from 4 January 2011, on a permanent basis, at the following designed coordinates.

MOF Front Lead L1 (permanent): 20° 47.686'S, 115°28.670'E
MOF Rear Lead L2 (permanent): 20° 47.609'S, 115°28.302'E

These navigational aids are equipped with lighting systems in accordance with the IALA Maritime Buoyage System.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when transiting the area and keep well clear of operations during navigational aid installation.
