**Temporary Notice to Mariners
Navigation Hazard
Restricted Area
Port of Barrow Island**

Mariners are advised that entry to the Port of Barrow Island is restricted and permission must first be obtained from the Barrow Island Marine Controller on VHF Channel 10 prior to entering port limits. The port now maintains a 24 hour Marine VHF radio watch.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when transiting the area and to contact the Barrow Island Marine Controller to obtain clearance prior to entering the Port of Barrow Island which is now a restricted area.
