**Temporary Notice to Mariners  
Navigational Hazard  
Spoil Ground  
Port of Barrow Island  
Amended Coordinates**

Mariners are advised that a previous Temporary Notice to Mariners (Not2010/148) published in the West Australian and Pilbara News on 29 December 2010 contained incorrect coordinates and has been revoked and replaced by this amended Notice.

This Notice advises that the spoil ground located on the south eastern edge of the port has undergone significant recent changes to chartered depths indicated on AUS Chart 742.

The coordinates of the spoil ground are as follows:
