Mariners are advised that a total of twenty three (23) cyclone moorings have been installed in the Mangrove Passage area of Onslow.

All 23 cyclone mooring installations are installed and located between the following positions:

Each Cyclone Mooring is marked with a yellow marker buoy, lit flashing, visible to 2nm.

Mariners are advised to navigate with extreme caution when transiting the area and to navigate well clear of the marker buoys.
