Temporary Notice to Mariners

NAVIGATIONAL HAZARD Establishment of Environmental Monitoring Sites Shallow Waters, Port Walcott

Mariners are advised that a series of environmental monitoring sites have been established in shallow waters at the following locations within Port Walcott limits until 31 March 2014.

As plotted on Chart AUS 55, Datum WGS84, and printed 03/04/2006:

Dixon Island West (Inshore): Lat 20°37.794 ' , Long 117°02.838 '

Elephant Rock (Inshore): Lat 20°36.888 ' , Long 117°04.524 '

Anketell Rock (Inshore): Lat 20°37.296 , Long 117°06.120 '

Bells Reef (Midshore): Lat 20°35.058 ' , Long 117°08.580 '

Bezout Island (Midshore): Lat 20°33.270 ' , Long 117°10.272 '

Delambre island East (Offshore): Lat 20°27.840 ' , Long 117°03.966 '

Delambre Island West (Offshore): Lat 20°27.840 ' , Long 117°05.394 '

These sites have been established in close proximity to coral reefs, and consist of a star picket embedded into the seabed (with monitoring station attached), with adjacent mooring buoy.

The mooring buoys are unlit and no vessel is to moor to them at any time.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when transiting the above vicinities and to remain clear of the above mooring buoys at all times.
