Temporary Notice to Mariners

Deployment of Monitoring Stations James Price Point Time Extension

This Notice extends Not2010-116, published in The Broome Advertiser on 28 October 2010.

Mariners are advised that 12 monitoring sites already established to undertake marine baseline studies approx 20km north & south of James Price Point will remain in place until around November 2012.

Chart Reference: AUS 324

Each monitoring site comprises sensors and logging equipment which is secured to a seabed frame attached to a yellow 60cm surface marker buoy (unlit).

No vessel is to moor to, or interfere with, the above surface marker buoys at any time as this may dislodge the seabed monitoring equipment.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when transiting the area.
