## Notice to Mariners

### Closure of Waters

### Boating Prohibited

### Esperance Bay – Tanker Jetty

Acting pursuant to Section 66 of the Western Australian Marine Act 1982, Mariners are advised that as of 24<sup>th</sup> September 2009 the following area of water is now closed to all boating:-

#### **Esperance Bay-Tanker Jetty**

This Notice advises that all the waters adjacent to the head of the Esperance Tanker Jetty as delineated below are now closed to navigation by all vessel until further notice.

The closed area as plotted on Chart Aus 119 (Datum WGS 84, new edition April 2004) is defined by the following coordinate boundary points:-

**Lat 33°51.228'S      Long 121°54.454'E**

**Lat 33°51.303'S      Long 121°54.608'E**

**Lat 33°51.350'S      Long 121°54.575'E**

**Lat 33°51.275'S      Long 121°54.421'E**

The boundary corners of the closed area will also be identified by "Boating Prohibited" yellow special mark unlit pillar buoys.

**Mariners are advised that all vessels other than those directed and approved by the Department of Transport are excluded from access to the above closure zone.**
