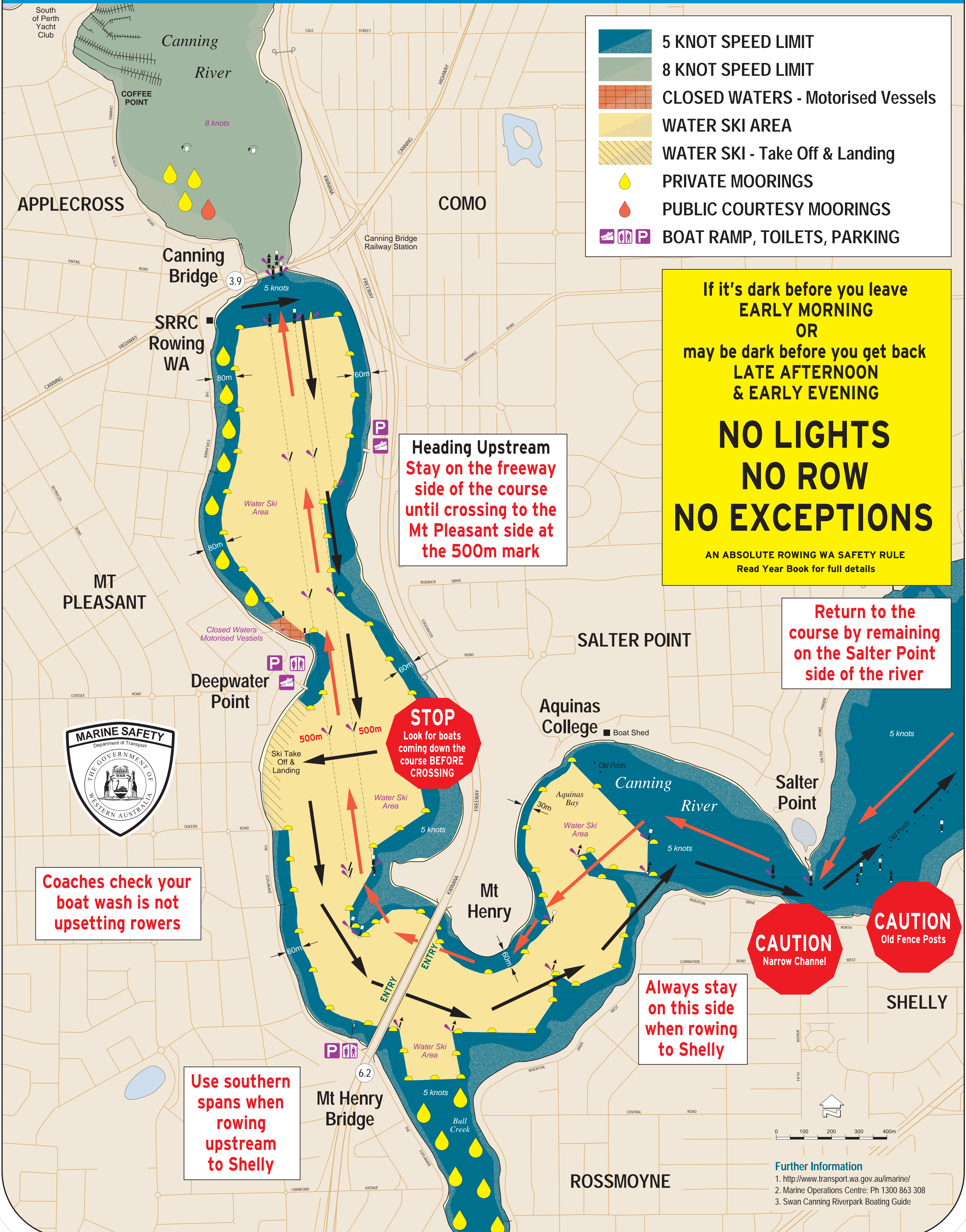




Mount Pleasant Rowing Course

Marine Safety Information



- 5 KNOT SPEED LIMIT
- 8 KNOT SPEED LIMIT
- CLOSED WATERS - Motorised Vessels
- WATER SKI AREA
- WATER SKI - Take Off & Landing
- PRIVATE MOORINGS
- PUBLIC COURTESY MOORINGS
- BOAT RAMP, TOILETS, PARKING

If it's dark before you leave
EARLY MORNING
OR
may be dark before you get back
LATE AFTERNOON & EARLY EVENING

NO LIGHTS
NO ROW
NO EXCEPTIONS

AN ABSOLUTE ROWING WA SAFETY RULE
Read Year Book for full details

Heading Upstream
Stay on the freeway side of the course until crossing to the Mt Pleasant side at the 500m mark

Return to the course by remaining on the Salter Point side of the river

STOP
Look for boats coming down the course BEFORE CROSSING

CAUTION
Narrow Channel

CAUTION
Old Fence Posts

Coaches check your boat wash is not upsetting rowers

Always stay on this side when rowing to Shelly

Use southern spans when rowing upstream to Shelly
