

Port Gregory Maritime Facility

Code of Conduct

CURRENTLY PORT GREGORY JETTY IS EXPERIENCING VERY LOW WATER LEVELS AND CANNOT BE ACCESSED BY A VESSEL.

The code of conduct for the maritime facility is:

- Fees apply for the use of this facility.
- Speed strictly 5 knots within anchorage area.
- The jetty is for the purpose of loading and unloading only. Prolonged stay is prohibited.
- Vessels must not remain on the wharf or jetty for extended periods without permission from Department of Transport. Email <u>MidWest@transport.wa.gov.au</u> or phone 9216 8170.
- Vessels loading, or unloading, are required to transfer directly between vehicle and vessel.
 Vessel and vehicle to leave jetty upon completion of loading.
- Dinghies not to be moored on the low landing.
- Please show courtesy and consideration to others especially during peak usage periods.
- Pots or gear must not remain on the jetty without permission from Department of Transport.
- Dumping of offal or fish carcasses, large or small, strictly prohibited within anchorage area or jetty precincts.
- No rubbish, including bait boxes or plastic, to be dumped at sea and all rubbish to be placed in rubbish bins.
- Authorised vehicles only permitted.
- No swimming, diving, or jumping from this jetty.
- Bicycles and prams are not permitted on jetty.
- Dogs to be on a leash or restrained on vehicles.
