# **Coral Bay Maritime Facility**

Coral Bay is located 1,200 kilometres north of Perth, in the Gascoyne region. It is close to Ningaloo Reef, Australia's only fringing reef, within easy access of swimmers, including children. Snorkelling and fishing are also popular.

The facility contains a double boat ramp, 2 finger jetties, a service jetty, 11 dinghy pens, toilets and car parking.

### **Boating facility fees**

Fees are payable for the use of maritime facilities throughout the state. Please refer to the schedule of maritime facilities fees and charges. *http://www.transport.wa.gov.au/imarine/facilities-and-waterway-fees.asp* 

All customers should contact the Department of Transport's (DoT) Exmouth office prior to arrival to ensure suitable facilities are available and to receive all relevant documentation and facilitate payment.

#### **Marine rescue**

All marine rescue groups monitor radio listening watches on marine radio:

• 27.88 MHz and

Mobile:

• VHF Channel 90 and 16.

Most groups also monitor other frequencies such as:

- 27.90 MHz, 27.91 MHz and
- VHF channels 72 and 73,

as well as their own channels.

Don't hesitate to call any marine rescue group on your marine radio.

Remember to log on before heading out and log off when you return with your local marine rescue group, for full radio procedure refer to Boat rules at a glance.
