

Woodman Point Recreational Boating Precinct



The 250 hectare Woodman Point Regional Park is located 22 kilometres south-south-east of Perth and is 8 kilometres south of Fremantle. It has 6.5 hectares of coastline and direct access to a pristine beach.

The Woodman Point Recreational Boating Precinct contains eight boat ramps, jetties and a floating pontoon. Further development of the site is being planned.

An ablution block is available for use by the general public.

Public car parks

There is a public car and trailer car park for 200 car and trailer bays. A further 220 trailer parking bays was opened in December 2016.

Volunteer Marine Rescue Group

All volunteer marine rescue groups monitor radio listening watches on marine radio 27.88 MHz and VHF Channel 16. Most groups also monitor other frequencies such as 27.90 MHz, 27.91 MHz and VHF channels 72 and 73, as well as their own channels.

Don't hesitate to call any volunteer marine rescue group on your marine radio.

Remember to log on before heading out and log off when you return with your local volunteer marine rescue group, for full radio procedure refer to Boat rules at a glance.
