Class No.	CLASS OF VEHICLE	
1A	Motor Vehicle - Any motor vehicle used for private or business purposes and constructed principally for the conveyance of persons not included in Classes 2 to 8, inclusive. This class includes station wagons which have a designed seating capacity for four or more persons.	
2	Goods Vehicle - Any motor vehicle not included in Classes 3 to 8, both inclusive, constructed principally for the conveyance of goods and used for private or business purposes. This class includes a wagon, utility, tractor (prime mover type).	
	2(f) Any vehicle within this class with tare weight of 2,500 kilograms or more owned by a farmer and used solely or principally for carrying the products of, or requisites for, the owners' farming business (see notes below)	
3	Any motor vehicle operating for hire or reward or, Hire-and Drive-Yourself vehicles. This class also includes buses us on a not for profit basis, i.e. where only a contribution toward ordinary running costs is received by the owner.	ed
	3(a) Any motor vehicle licensed under the <i>Road Traffic (Vehicles) Regulations 2014</i> and used as a Passenger Transport Vehicle for hire or reward, having more than nine seating positions, including driver, principally operating within a 40 kilometre radius of the GPO Perth. This excludes motor vehicles originally designed with nine seats or less, including driver, that have been subsequently modified to have more than nine seats (e.g. stretch limousines).	
	3(b) Any motor vehicle licensed under the <i>Road Traffic</i> (<i>Vehicles</i>) <i>Regulations 2014</i> and used as a Passenger Transport Vehicle for hire or reward, having more than nine seating positions, including driver, principally operating outside a 40-kilometre radius of the GPO Perth. This excludes motor vehicles originally designed with nine seats or less, including driver, that have been subsequently modified to have more than nine seats (e.g. stretch limousines).	
	3(c) Any motor vehicle licensed under the <i>Road Traffic</i> (<i>Vehicles</i>) <i>Regulations 2014</i> and used as an On-demand Rank or Hail (taxi) Passenger Transport Vehicle, as defined in the <i>Transport (Road Passenger Services) Act 2018</i> , principally operating within a 40 kilometre radius of the GPO Perth.	
	3(d) Any motor vehicle licensed under the <i>Road Traffic</i> (<i>Vehicles</i>) <i>Regulations 2014</i> and used as an On-demand Rank or Hail (taxi) Passenger Transport Vehicle, as defined in the <i>Transport (Road Passenger Services) Act 2018</i> , principally operating outside a 40 kilometre radius of the GPO Perth.	
	3(e) Any bus that is not used as a Passenger Transport Vehicle for hire or reward. This includes school buses used exclusively for the carriage of children to and from school.	
	3(f) Any motor vehicle used as a Passenger Transport Vehicle for hire or reward not included in Classes 3(a) to 3(e) inclusive.	
	3(g) Hire-and-Drive-Yourself vehicle (other than motorcycles included in Class 7(a)).	
4	Motorcycle - Used for private or business purposes. Other than motorcycles included in Classes 5(b)* and 7(a)** *With Trade plate attached issued under <i>Road Traffic (Vehicles) Regulations 2014.</i>

To be eligible to licence a vehicle with Motor Injury Insurance Class 2(f) the vehicle must:

- · have a tare weight of 2500 kg or more;
- be licensed as a motor wagon or prime mover (licence fee type 02 or 16);
- be owned by a farmer (primary producer) and used in the business of farming/grazing. A primary producer is a person who cultivates or uses their own or someone else's land for their own benefit:
 - for producing fruit, grain, flowers, vegetables, tobacco or farm/agricultural produce; or
 - for dairy farming, poultry and other bird farming, pig farming, bee keeping or oyster/fish culture; or
 - for a nursery; or
 - for rearing or grazing horses, cattle or sheep, or
 - gathering leaves from which eucalyptus or other oil is distilled; and
- be used solely or principally for carrying the products of, or requisites for, the owners' farming business.
