Provided that a waiting list is active in the Mooring Control Area (MCA), your mooring site may be offered to the next suitable applicant on the waiting list if the mooring site is suitable for relicensing.

What happens after the surrender of my mooring licence takes effect?

In accordance with regulation 21 of the *Mooring Regulations 1998*.

- If your mooring licence is associated with a mooring site in an MCA without an active waiting list; or
- If the next suitable applicant on the waiting list is offered a mooring licence over the mooring site that was previously registered to you;
 - but, does not contact you, or
 - contacts you but the negotiation for the sale of your mooring apparatus is not successful.
- DTMI will direct you, in writing, to remove your mooring apparatus from the mooring site within a specified time.
- After removing your mooring apparatus, you will be eligible for a proportional refund of your annual mooring licence fee.
- Failure to comply with the directive to remove the mooring apparatus is an offence and may result in;
 - a fine of \$2000, and
 - DTMI removing and destroying the mooring apparatus, and
 - DTMI recovering the costs of removing your mooring apparatus as a debt due to the State in a court of competent jurisdiction.
