

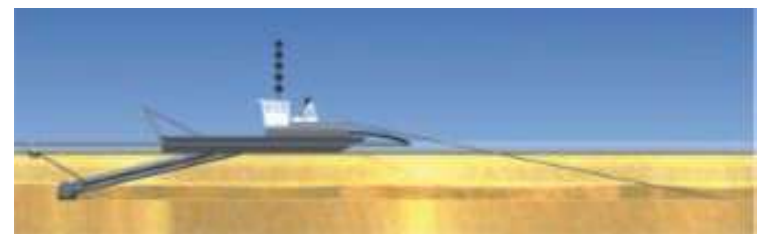
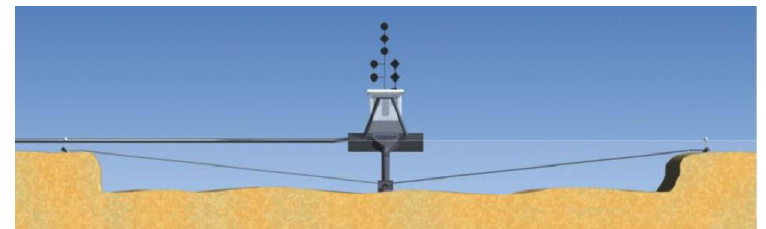
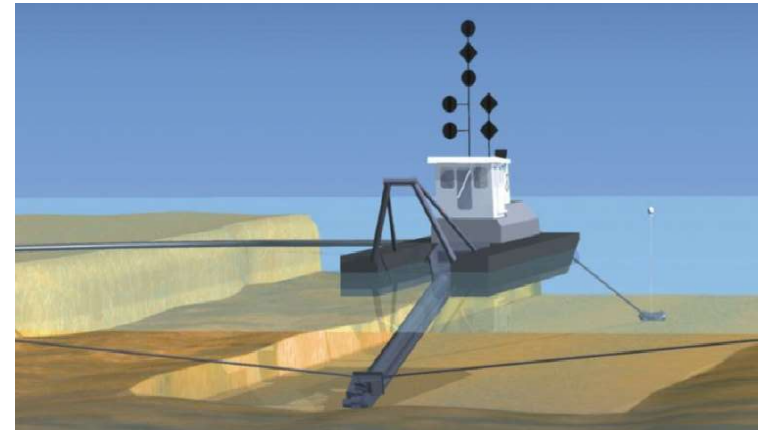
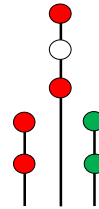


Western Australian Statewide Maintenance Dredging Works

Safe Navigation near Dredge Vessels

If the channel is obstructed, the vessel will display shapes and lights indicating its *Restricted Ability to Manoeuvre* in accordance with the Prevention of Collisions at Sea Regulations 1983.

- **Pass on the side showing two diamonds** during the day
- **Pass on the side showing two green lights** at night
- Pass at 4 knots or less
- Pass close and to the side of the dredge
- Never approach within 100m directly astern (rear) of the dredge
- Be aware of the dredge pipeline to the stern of the dredge and subsequent pathway marked by buoys and lights.
- Be aware the pipeline may move, and submerged sections may re-float during operations
