Pursuant to the Jetties Regulations 1940, the following Terms and Conditions are requirements of the registered owner and or master of a vessel. In consideration of the grant of this application/permit, you acknowledge and undertake to observe, perform and be bound by these terms and conditions; by the Jetties Regulations 1940, and/or the signs posted on each jetty by the Department of Transport (DoT), at all times.

Terms and Conditions

- The use of a service jetty or wharf at a DoT maritime facility is intended for a short period and not for extended berthing.
- Although the annual permit allows a maximum use period of up to one hour within a 24 hour period, shorter duration of use may be applied to accommodate other vessel use of the jetty.
- Any use by a service vessel, or any use by a vessel exceeding one hour, is not covered by this annual permit and will be subject to casual daily fees as prescribed by regulation.
- Any vessel alongside a service jetty or wharf is to be manned by a competent person at all times to enable the vessel to be moved to make way for other vessels that need to access the jetty or wharf.
- A current approval and or sticker for short-term use of a service jetty or wharf is to be carried on the vessel at all times and produced on demand to an authorised officer of the DoT.
- This is not a valid approval until all fees are paid and an authorised officer of the DoT has signed the form.

Swan and Canning Rivers

Further to the above conditions, the following applies specifically to the Swan and Canning Rivers:

- Vessels must not stay alongside any service jetty or wharf within the Swan and Canning Rivers for a period greater than 15 minutes at any one time to cater for demand. Further restrictions will apply at Burswood Jetty on event days, refer to jetty signage.
- The annual berthing permit does not apply to any jetty for which an exclusive berthing permit has been issued.
- Priority is to be given to commercial ferries that are operating a scheduled service at any DoT jetty.
- This application form, once approved and fee paid, constitutes a permit under the Jetties Regulations 1940 to use public jetties on the Swan and Canning Rivers for the purpose of taking on and/or setting down of passengers as required.

I acknowledge that accounts for all additional facility services payment terms are strictly 30 days from the date of invoice.
