An RPT service is a service for the transport of passengers by road within, or partly within the State for hire or reward that is conducted according to regular routes and timetables or according to regular routes and at regular intervals.

When assessing variations, the Department of Transport (DoT) will consider the impact of the variation against current services that are provided, and against the items listed in s.62(1) of the Act.
