



Proof of Identity

Application Requirements



You must supply a number of documents as proof of your identity when applying for a learner's permit, driver's licence or photo card.

You must provide a combination of five original documents, from the two combination options below:

Category A

- Birth certificate.

Category B

- WA photo card.
- Parental identification and statutory declaration.

Category C

- Australian bank statement less than 6 months old.
- Medicare card.
- Healthcare card.
- Centrelink card or statement.
- Proof of age card.

Category D

- Letter from Principal of a recognised educational institution showing residential address, less than 12 months old.
- Letter from current employer showing residential address, less than 6 months old.
- Current residential tenancy agreement.
- Letter from Driving Access and Equity Program organisations showing residential address.

Please note some Category C documents that include a current residential address can be used for Category D. Please speak to a staff member about what other documents are accepted or visit www.transport.wa.gov.au/licensing for more information.
