

Ride from the Guildford Station to Whiteman Park

Guildford Station to Whiteman Park

This route is suitable for older children and adults with experience riding in traffic.

1. Guildford Station

- Once you have disembarked from the train you should walk your bike along the platform towards Perth.



- At the level crossing turn right and travel through the car park area to Victoria Street.

2. Victoria Street to West Swan Road

- Turn right out of the car park into Victoria Street. Continue along Victoria Street to the T junction at the end of the street.
- Turn left onto Johnson Street and follow the road round the corner to the roundabout with Meadow Street.
- Turn left at the roundabout and travel north on Meadow Street, crossing the Swan River using the path section on Barkers Bridge. North of Barkers Bridge the road becomes West Swan Road.

3. West Swan Road to Arthur Street

- Continue north on West Swan Road, passing Lilac Hill Park on the right and several wineries.

- More confident cyclists may wish to ride on the road, whereas less confident riders can use the shared path facilities along this section.

- Turn left into Arthur Street.

4. Arthur Street to Marshall Road

- Travel north on Arthur Street to the cul de sac.
- At the cul de sac there is a connection to a shared path.

Warning: Path connection has a tight turn and bollard.

- Follow the shared path through the underpass beneath Reid Highway.

Warning: There is a bollard in the middle of the path on the northern side of the underpass.

- The path finishes at Victoria Street. Turn right into Victoria Street and then first left into Arthur Street.

- Continue north on Arthur Street past Coast Road then turn left into Marshall Road.

5. Marshall Road to Whiteman Park

- Travel west along Marshall Road until the T junction with Lord Street.

Warning: Ignore the directional sign to Whiteman Park at this T junction.

- Turn left into Lord Street, and then first right into Marshall Road.

Warning: Lord Street is a busy road with no shared path facilities. Riders should exercise caution when undertaking this manoeuvre.

- Continue west along Marshall Road until Dulwich Street.

Warning: Marshall Road is a busy road with no shared path facilities. Riders should ride in the sealed shoulder area and keep as far left as possible.

- Turn right into Dulwich Street. Continue north along Dulwich Street to the Whiteman Park

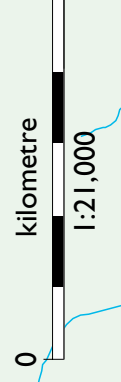

Whiteman Park Facts

Located in the Swan Valley in the upper reaches of the Swan River, Whiteman Park is a short 20 minute train ride from Perth City and an easy 30 minute cycle from Guildford Station.

The park covers more than 3700 hectares, eight times the size of Kings Park. Nearly half of this is designated as a conservation reserve.

The park takes its name from Mr Lew Whiteman (1903-1994), a prominent local identity and an enthusiastic and eclectic collector. His family settled in Guildford from England in the late 19th century and in the 1940s, Lew acquired land around what is now known as RIDGE Mussel Pool.

Today, Whiteman Park is home to the historic Whiteman Collection, a tractor and motor museum, a restored and operating passenger train and tram network, spectacular playgrounds, a network of bike and walk paths, international-standard sporting facilities and picnic areas.

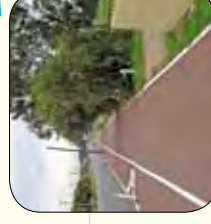
