



WA Bicycle Network Grants

2019-20/2020-21 Expression of Interest Form

The Western Australian Bicycle Network (WABN) grants program is an initiative of the Western Australian State Government, administered by the Department of Transport (DoT).

Grant funding is available to local governments in Western Australia, up to 50 per cent of the total project cost, for the planning and implementation of bicycle network infrastructure in accordance with State Government priorities set out in the WABN Plan.

Projects are encouraged to be spread over two financial years to facilitate high quality planning and design. To enable project staging, funding may be applied for in both the 2019-20 and 2020-21 financial years.

Important

This form is for application to the Expression of Interest (EOI) stage only. All applicants will be notified of the status of their EOI application in early September 2018 and shortlisted projects will then be invited to apply to the Full Proposal round.
