



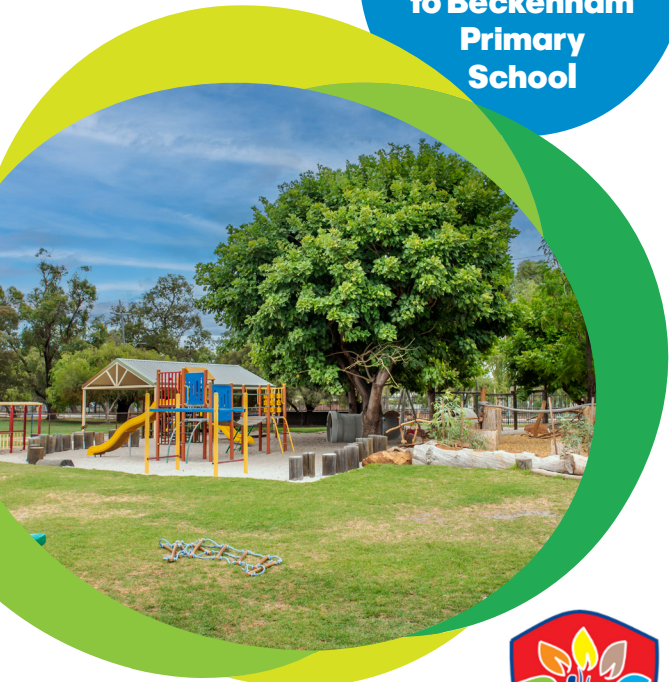

If walking or riding the whole way to school isn't an option, ask your parents to park nearby then walk or ride the rest of the way!

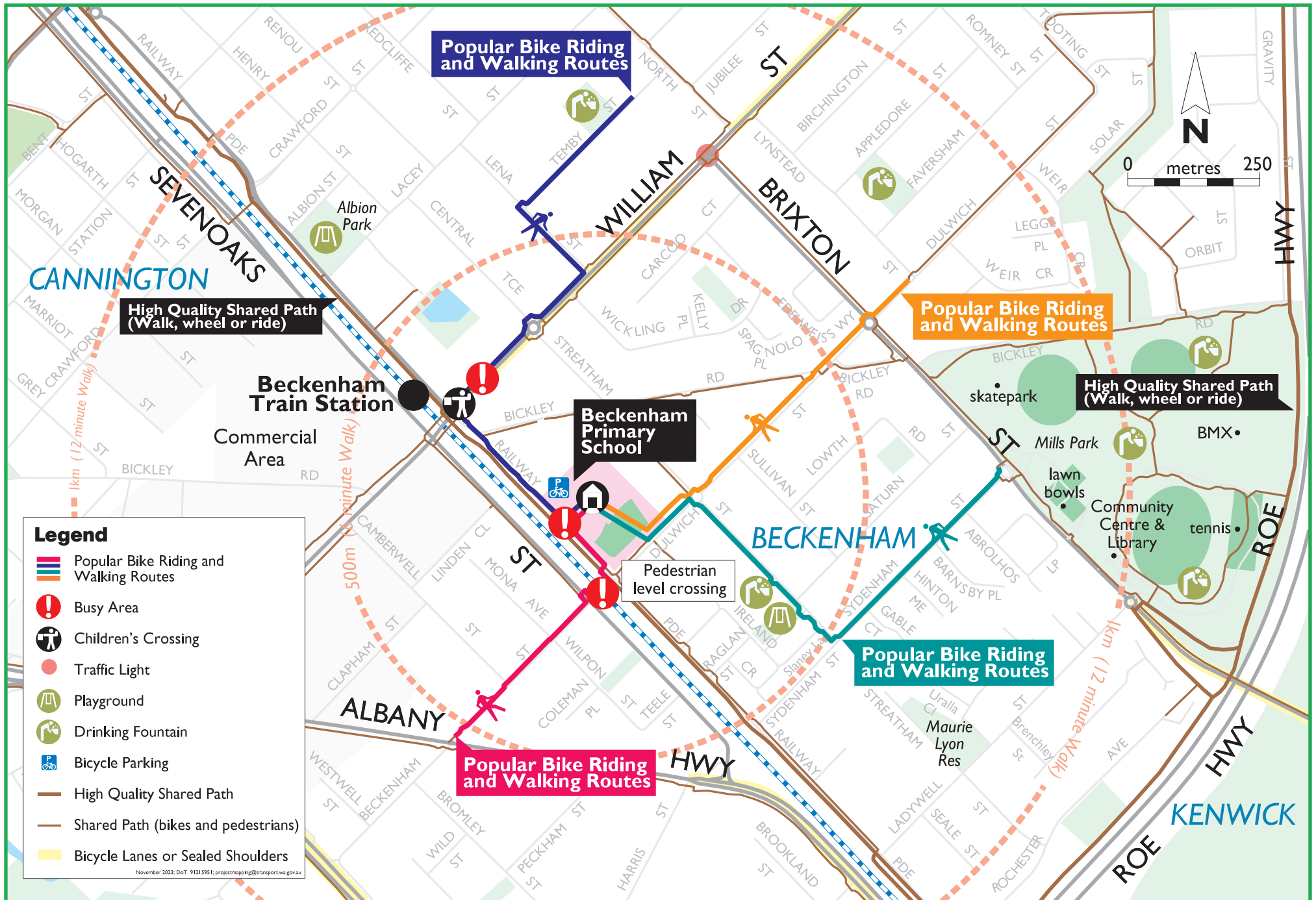
