Strategic Airport Assets and Financial Management Framework (Framework) Overview

- The Regional Airports Development Scheme (RADS) recognises the challenges for both regional airports and airlines to operate sustainably in remote and regional centres of Western Australia.
- The Framework aims to enable a consistent, transparent and documented approach to the management of airports across Western Australia. The approach aims to enable prudent financial management of airport assets and setting of airport charges that are supported by relevant stakeholders.
- The State Government is not wanting to control airports or their setting of airport fees.
- What airport data is shared from the Framework will be at the discretion of the airport owner.
- The Framework sets a process that allows an airport and airline to have open and transparent discussions on the setting of airport fees.
- A Framework will be mandatory as at 1 July 2019 for all regional RPT airports wanting to secure RADS funding or a Department of Transport's Letter of Support for Commonwealth funding applications.
- The RADS will fully fund the creation of a regional RPT airport's Framework. By agreeing to have a Framework the airport owner also agrees to ensure the Framework is updated annually. The future major revision of an airport's Framework will be co-funded through RADS.
