

MINISTERIAL DECLARATION OF EXEMPTION

Under Regulation 4A of the *Road Traffic Code 2000*

I, Hon Michelle Roberts MLC, Minister for Road Safety, declare the following provision of the *Road Traffic Code 2000* does not apply to the persons set out in this Declaration, under the conditions specified.

1. Relevant Provision

Regulation 260 of the *Road Traffic Code* insofar as it prohibits a person from driving or drawing a vehicle unless provision is made for its movement on wheels and no part of it, other than the wheels, comes into contact with the road.

2. Relevant Persons

The provision specified in Item 1 does not apply to the driver of a vehicle where:

- 2.1 The relevant vehicle is a vehicle which travels on continuous tracks which are made of rubber or are rubber-tipped; and
- 2.2 The vehicle is conditionally licensed for road use subject to the limitations or requirements imposed by the Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Transport, in accordance with the class of vehicle licence as prescribed under section 17 of the *Road Traffic (Vehicles) Act 2012*.

3. Conditions under which Declaration is valid

This Declaration is subject to the following conditions:

- 3.1 This Declaration is only valid from 1 August 2019 to 31 August 2020 (inclusive).
- 3.2 This Declaration is only valid where both the driver of the vehicle and the vehicle comply with all relevant conditions, requirements and limitations of the vehicle licence.
- 3.3 The person in charge of the vehicle must be appropriately licensed to drive the vehicle, and comply with all other provisions of the *Road Traffic Code 2000*.

4. Other conditions

A copy of this Declaration must be carried in the vehicle and produced at the request of a police officer or other authorised body.
