- Notification from organisation that experienced data breach/cyberattack confirming your licence/permit details have been exposed; or
- Identity Crime Certificate issued by a state or commonwealth Court (if applicable); or
- Letter from a law enforcement agency confirming you have been a victim of identity fraud.

To lodge your application by post you must also supply the following:

- Certified copies of primary and secondary proof of identification (information on acceptable proof of identity documents can be located online at www.transport.wa.gov.au/dvs).
- WA Police incident report number - for stolen driver's licence documents only.
- Supporting evidence of compromised details (if applicable).
 - Notification from organisation that experienced data breach/cyberattack confirming your licence/permit details have been exposed; or
 - Identity Crime Certificate issued by a state or commonwealth Court (if applicable); or
 - Letter from a law enforcement agency confirming you have been a victim of identity fraud.
- Payment for lost, damaged and replacement cards and documents (if applicable).
