Seat Belt Repairers Organisations Approved to Repair Seat Belts

The Department of Transport (DoT) permits certain organisations to carry out seat belt repairs in Western Australia. These organisations are listed below.

The minimum conditions that must be met by organisations carrying out seat belt repairs, and the requirements that are applicable in carrying out the work are stipulated in the *Circular to Industry CI-109, Seat Belt Repairers*.

Repairs are restricted to replacement of webbing only, without any repair or modification of mechanical components permitted.

Seat belt assemblies must not be repaired if there is evidence or knowledge that the assembly has been subject to loading in a vehicle accident or that the vehicle was subject to flood damage.

Repair of seat belts may be carried out only by organisations that have been approved by the DoT; the DoT has approved the following companies to carry out seat belt repairs (current October 2017):
