



# Batavia Coast Marina (Geraldton)



The Batavia Coast Marina is located in Geraldton in the Midwest region, 424 kilometres north of Perth. Geraldton is the windsurfing and kitesurfing capital of Australia, and the Abrolhos Islands are a popular destination for fishing and diving.

The marina has one jetty, 84 floating pens, boat launching ramps, toilets, car park, fishing platform and a boardwalk.

## Boating facility fees

# Boating facilities

## Jetty A

<b>Number of pens</b>	42
<b>Lengths</b>	20 x 10m 12 x 12m 5 x 15m 3 x 18m 2 x 18m (catamaran pens)
<b>Services</b>	Water, single and 3 phase power, lighting. Gates with security card access and future provisions for CCTV.

## Jetty B

<b>Number of pens</b>	42
<b>Lengths</b>	4 x 22m 4 x 20m 10 x 18m 20 x 15m 4 x 12m
<b>Services</b>	Water, single phase power, lighting. Gates with security card access and future provisions for CCTV.

# Other facilities and services

## Public toilets

Public toilets are located between the boat launching ramps and the car and trailer parking.

## Pen holders ablutions

Pen holders have access to an ablution block which includes hot showers and a laundry.

## Public car parks

There is a public car and trailer car park located to the east of the boat launching ramps. There are 168 car and trailer bays and 53 car bays.

## Boardwalk

A walkway with a railing, constructed over the water on the southern part of the harbour, provides a great place for pedestrians to view the harbour.

## Accessible fishing platform

There is an accessible fishing platform at the shore end of the new northern breakwater.

## Other attractions

The Midwest Museum is located at the marina and it is only a short walk to shops and the City Centre.

## Marine rescue

All volunteer marine rescue groups monitor radio listening watches on marine radio 27.88 MHz and VHF Channel 16. Most groups also monitor other frequencies such as 27.90 MHz, 27.91 MHz and VHF channels 72 and 73, as well as their own channels.

Don't hesitate to call any volunteer marine rescue group on your marine radio.

Remember to log on before heading out and log off when you return with your local volunteer marine rescue group, for full radio procedure refer to Boat rules at a glance.
