● **Assessment and Liaison Equipment**  
Broome, Karratha, Carnarvon Geraldton, Fremantle, Albany, Esperance

**Coverage area:** within 300km of stockpile location

**Mobilisation method:** Drive/vessel any coastal location within 300km of stockpile location

● **Field Response Equipment – North West**  
Karratha

**Coverage Area:** Kimberly, Pilbara and Mid-West-Gascoyne districts

● **Mobilisation Method:** Drive/tow any coastal location north of Carnarvon and west of Broome

● **Mobilisation Method:** Fly/freight any coastal location south of Carnarvon and east of Broome

★ **Incident Management Equipment**  
Fremantle

**Coverage Area:** Whole State

● **Mobilisation Method:** Drive/tow any coastal location south of Geraldton and west of Esperance

● **Mobilisation Method:** Fly/freight any coastal location north of Geraldton and west of Esperance

● **Field Response Equipment – South West**  
Fremantle

**Coverage Area:** Mid-West-Gascoyne, Wheatbelt, Metropolitan, South-West, Great Southern and Goldfields-Esperance districts

● **Mobilisation Method:** Drive/tow any coastal location south of Geraldton and west of Esperance

● **Mobilisation Method:** Fly/freight any coastal location north of Geraldton and west of Esperance
