



Ocean Reef Boat Harbour Maintenance Dredging

The Department of Transport (DoT) is undertaking maintenance dredging at Ocean Reef Boat Harbour to maintain navigable channels and ensure safe access.

Mariners are advised to navigate with caution when traversing the dredge area and to establish radio communications with the dredger.

VHF Channel 73
Marine 27MHz Channel 90

The dredged material will be pumped south of the harbour. In the interest of public safety, sections of the beach and limestone area may be temporarily closed to the public during disposal operations.

The dredger will maintain a navigational passage where possible when manoeuvring within the boat harbour. A floating discharge pipeline, lit with yellow flashing lights, will run between the dredger and the adjacent shore.
