3. When having the photograph certified you **must** take with you photographic identification, for example, a **current WA Drivers' Licence or passport** and have the Certifying Person Details section completed on the application form by an authorised person.

The following people are authorised to witness your application and certify your photograph;

- The chief executive officer or deputy chief executive officer of a local government
 - A member of the local council of a local government
 - An electoral registrar appointed under the Electoral Act of 1907
 - A person appointed to take charge of a post office in the state of Western Australia
 - An officer of the State or Commonwealth public service
 - A teacher within the meaning of the Education Act 1928
 - A police officer
 - A person appointed to take charge of the head of any branch office in the state of a bank carrying on business under the Banking Act 1959 of the Commonwealth or under a written law of the state
 - A secretary of an organisation of employees or employers registered under the Industrial Relations Act 1979 or of an organisation registered under the Conciliation and Arbitration Act 1904 of the Commonwealth
 - A legal practitioner within the meaning of the Legal Practitioners Act 1893
 - A medical practitioner registered under the Medical Act 1964
 - A pharmaceutical chemist within the meaning of the Pharmacy Act 1964
 - A member of the academic staff of an institution providing courses at post-secondary education level
 - The holder of a licence under the Real Estate and Business Agents Act 1981
 - An insurance broker registered under the Insurance (Agents and Brokers) Act 1978 of the Commonwealth
 - A person registered as an auditor or a liquidator under the Companies (WA) code
 - A person who is license under the Licensed Surveyors Act 1909
 - A patent attorney registered under the Patents Act 1990 of the Commonwealth
 - A Justice of the Peace
