



Determination – exempt area in relation to emergency declaration

Transport (Road Passenger Services) Regulations 2020

TRPSR-2021-204035

I, Iain Cameron, delegate of the Chief Executive Officer of the Department of Transport, for the purposes of regulation 129(3) of the *Transport (Road Passenger Services) Regulations 2020* (TRPSR) hereby make the following determination pursuant to regulation 129A(1) of the TRPSR:

- the area of the State of Western Australia is an exempt area (the exempt area); and
- the exempt area is exempt in relation to the “Declaration of State of Emergency” declared pursuant to the *Emergency Management Act 2005* (WA) (EMA) at 12:45pm on 15 March 2020 in respect of the pandemic caused by virus COVID-19.

Note: regulation 129 of the TRPSR prohibits the charging of fares that include an element of surge pricing or a queue-jumping fee for an on-demand passenger transport service in an area to which an emergency declaration under the EMA applies, unless the CEO has determined under regulation 129A that the area is an exempt area in relation to all emergency declarations applicable to that area.

This determination takes effect on and from the day on which it is made, and ceases to have effect when the emergency declaration specified in the determination ceases to be in force (unless sooner revoked).
