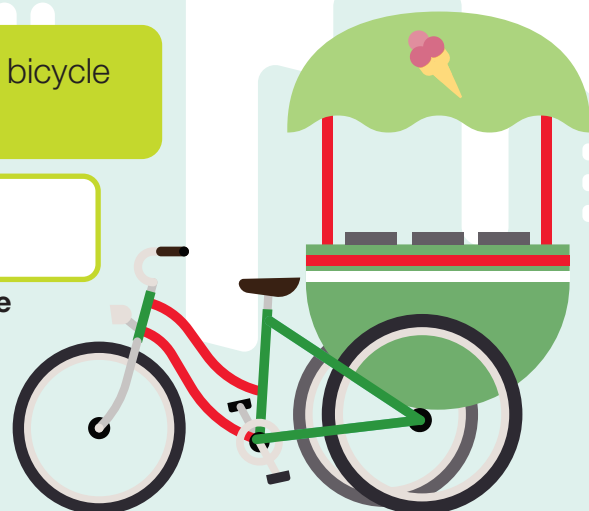

Logic puzzle

While solving the puzzle you may need to reread clues or return to them later when more of the puzzle is solved.

To help you get started, the first two clues are solved for you.

Clues:

- Ash loves riding to school with friends. It's a time to talk about weekend plans.
- The student with the black bike is from Victoria Park Primary School.

- Sam loves the environment, and all things green.
- The student from John Curtin College of the Arts rides a red bike among friends, and the student from Aveley North Primary School rides a green bike.
- Louise doesn't go to Victoria Park Primary School, neither does Sam.
- Fun is very important to the student from East Butler Primary School, who doesn't ride a red or black bike.

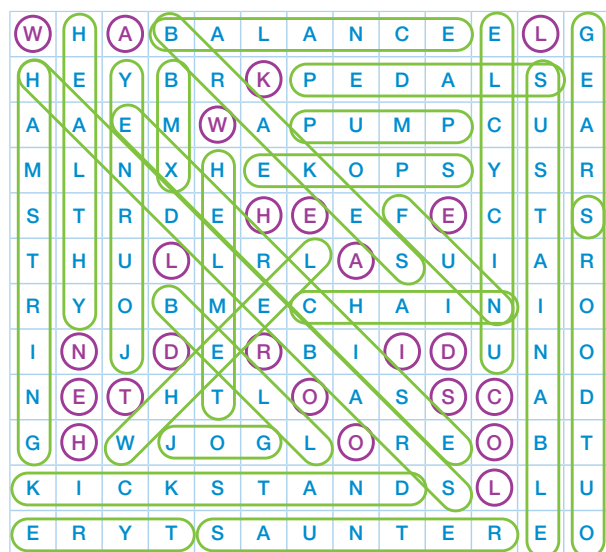
