Battery damage warning signs



Very hot to the touch



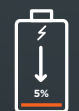
Colour change



Change in shape
(e.g. swelling or distortion)



Producing smoke,
odour or leaking



Not keeping a charge

If your eRideable battery is damaged or reached the end of its life, tape over the terminals and dispose of it correctly.



Overcharged or damaged
batteries can catch fire



Lithium-ion batteries
don't belong in general
waste or recycling bins
